Footnotes

JACK O LYN sped to the early lead a bit off the rail, dueled between horses then outside the runner-up, regained the advantage into the stretch, inched away under some left handed urging in midstretch and drew off under an energetic hand ride. ARATHORN a bit slow to begin, went up inside to duel for the lead, put a head in front on the turn, fought back leaving the bend, was no match for the winner in the stretch but clearly second best. OFFICER BAVETTA prompted the pace three deep leaving the backstretch then stalked off the rail on the turn, lacked the needed response in the stretch but bested the others. ZAIRSACAT pulled his way between horses then stalked a bit off the rail, angled in for the turn and lacked the needed rally. WARREN'S MARSHALL stalked three deep then between horses on the backstretch and outside a rival on the turn and weakened. NOLARUNINFOR JAYCI settled off the rail, angled in on the turn and was not a threat. PROMETHEUS BULL broke a bit slowly, chased outside then four wide leaving the backstretch, continued outside on the turn and did not rally. DEBITS AND CREDITS stalked between horses then dropped back off the rail on the turn, entered the stretch outside a rival and had little left for the drive.
