PROMISCUOUSUANCES sped to the early lead, set all the pace a bit off the rail and held gamely under a left handed tap of the whip and a strong hand ride. MISS BECCA stalked three deep, came four wide into the stretch and gained the place, then returned bleeding in the mouth. BIG TSIMMIS stalked just off the rail then inside leaving the hill, came out some into the stretch and held third between horses late. CHARM THE CROWD saved ground chasing the pace throughout and was edged for the show. PHI BETA HEAT settled outside then alongside a rival down the hill, came out some into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. BENECIA stalked off the rail then outside a rival leaving the hill, came out some into the stretch and weakened. HUNTINGTON HARBOUR stalked between horses or off the rail to the stretch and also weakened. COOKINTHISORTHAT allowed to settle off the pace inside, came out some leaving the hill and in the stretch and lacked a further response. Rail on hill at 14 feet.
