Footnotes

CALL ME SOON, chased outside a rival early and outside EXCESS PLEASURE on the turn, bid three deep into the stretch to gain the lead and pulled clear under urging. SULAYMONDO, broke slowly, went up inside on the backstretch, came out a bit on the turn, split rivals in deep stretch and gained the place. IMAGE OF GLORY, was close up inside on the backstretch, came out on the turn and three deep into the stretch and just got third. EXCESS PLEASURE, bobbled slightly at the start but quickly sped to the lead, prompted the pace inside on the backstretch, remained inside and tried to come back on in the stretch but just missed the show. GRISELLE, between rivals on the backstretch, angled on the turn and lacked the needed rally. SUCCESS IN EXCESS, hopped slightly in a bit of an awkward start, took the lead outside a rival on the backstretch, inched away on the turn but weakened in the stretch. SELF TAUGHT, raced four wide on the backstretch and three deep on the turn and did not rally. SUZIE SNOOP, three deep between foes early, angled in on the turn and failed to menace.
