MAKER OR BREAKER pulled three deep on the first turn then stalked outside a rival, bid between horses on the backstretch, took the lead into the second turn, inched away leaving that turn, kicked clear in the stretch and proved best under a left handed tap of the whip and steady handling. GOLDEN PRODUCTION saved ground stalking the pace, came out on the second turn and three wide into the stretch and was clearly second best. GLOWING SPIRIT (BRZ) bobbled slightly just after the start, chased off the rail, came three deep into the stretch and picked up the show. GELILA allowed to settle off the rail chasing the pace, split horses into the stretch and did not rally. COSSET pulled her way along off the rail then bid three deep on the backstretch, continued outside the winner on the second turn, dropped back into the stretch and weakened. BWANA BABE sped to the early lead and angled in, set the pace inside, dueled leaving the backstretch, dropped back into and on the second turn and gave way.
