Footnotes

SPACELINK, three deep on the first turn, stalked the pace outside a rival, bid three deep on the second turn and took a short lead outside the pacesetter, then drew clear under urging. NURDLINGER, broke slowly and was steadied, settled outside a rival, came four wide into the stretch and finished well. STORMY JACK, settled off the inside, moved up outside on the second turn, bid outside the winner into the stretch but settled for the show. KLEOFUS saved ground early, came out on the backstretch and three deep on the second turn and improved position. IT'S ALL INSTINCT, three deep on the first turn, chased outside, went four wide on the second turn and weakened. CEE THE FIELD, angled in early, went between rivals on the backstretch, moved up inside on the second turn, came out leaving that bend and lacked the needed late kick. DESERT SURGE, stalked between rivals early then off the rail to the second turn and weakened. NAUGHTY NACHO sped to the early lead, angled in on the first turn, held a clear advantage inside, offered little resistance when challenged and gave way. ON TIME AIRLINE, pulled between rivals early, chased off the rail, steadied sharply off heels midway on the second turn and dropped back. NORTH NORTHWEST, angled in and saved ground early, came out leaving the backstretch, split horses on the second turn and had little left. SERVICE TERM, saved ground tracking the pace and gave way.
