

PRINE TIMBER broke in and was bumped, settled wide, bid four wide leaving the turn, took a short lead and held on gamely. BRIGHT VALOUR was sent along inside, saved ground, went around WHITE WATER VIEW in upper stretch, then rallied gamely inside. SYDNEY'S OLYMPICS squeezed a bit at the start, moved up inside leaving the turn, swung out and finished well. TOJO forced the early pace four wide, angled in on the turn and split rivals a quarter mile out, bid between rivals in midstretch but weakened late. CARTEL dueled three deep early and outside WHITE WATER VIEW to the stretch, then weakened. LAZAR broke outward, was between rivals early, dropped back off the rail and weakened. NATIVE TWO STEPPER took up sharply when squeezed at the start, raced along the inside on the backstretch, came out three deep on the turn and did not rally. HURRICANE'S EYE stumbled to his nose at the start, raced well off the rail and was outrun. WHITE WATER VIEW sent inside early, dueled inside, began to weaken into the stretch and steadied when crowded in upper stretch, then dropped back.
