Footnotes

TRIBAL RAIN angled in and dueled between horses then a bit off the rail leaving the turn, kicked clear under urging past midstretch and held. FRENCH CURLS steadied when squeezed at the start, saved ground, moved up into the stretch, came off the rail in deep stretch and finished well. SECRET MEMO angled in and dueled three deep on the backstretch and turn, continued outside the winner into the stretch, battled outside that one in midstretch and weakened some late but held third. DERBY HAT stalked three deep between horses on the backstretch then outside or off the rail on the turn, came three wide into the stretch and was outfinished for the show. APALACHEE SONG had good early speed and angled in, dueled just off the rail then inside on the turn, dropped back into the stretch, came out a bit and weakened. HOT LIST steadied when squeezed back at the start, settled a bit off the rail chasing the pace and did not rally. LIL BARBIE DOODLE broke in onto foes, chased a bit off the rail then inside, came out leaving the turn and could not offer the necessary response. PANFILA chased between horses then outside a rival, was in tight into the turn, continued off the rail and lacked a response in the

stretch. JAZZ GIRL steadied when squeezed back at the start, settled just off the rail, split horses on the turn and was not a threat. TRINITY ROSE hopped in a bit of a slow start, settled four wide then three deep on the turn and into the stretch and did not rally. BETCHER BOOTY chased four wide then outside or off the rail on the turn and weakened. BLUEJOY saved ground chasing the pace, lugged out and steadied into the turn, steadied again nearing the quarter pole and gave way.
