Footnotes

TIZ DYNAMIC had speed between horses then inched away, set the pace a bit off the rail, continued just off the fence in the stretch and held on gamely

under urging. SPIT BALL a bit slow to begin, saved ground off the pace, moved up into the stretch, went around a rival in deep stretch and got up for second. UNUSUAL MYSTERY chased between horses then off the rail, continued a bit off the fence on the turn, came out in the stretch and was edged for the place. BROWN BOSS had speed between foes then stalked between horses, continued alongside a rival leaving the turn and three deep into the stretch and lacked the needed late kick. SUANCESONG chased between horses then a bit off the rail, angled in on the turn, came out some into the stretch and again in the drive and could not offer the necessary response. BECOME THE WIND bobbed at the start, settled off the rail, came out in the stretch and improved position. WARREN'S BUGLER had speed between horses then stalked just off the rail or inside, continued inside on the turn and in the stretch and weakened. ON HOLY GROUND in a bit tight between foes early, chased just off the rail then inside, came out leaving the turn and into the stretch and did not rally. PLAYFUL STUDENT had speed outside foes then stalked four wide, came out five wide into the stretch and weakened. GREEN TEAM had speed between rivals then stalked three deep, came four wide into the stretch and also weakened. MR. NIGHT FEVER wide early, chased outside then off the rail on the turn and lacked a response in the stretch. POPPY PEAK chased between horses then three deep leaving the backstretch, came out six wide into the stretch and weakened. HARLAN'S WEEKEND allowed to settle outside a rival then off the rail, dropped back on the turn, gave way and was eased in the stretch.
