Footnotes

GOLDENCENTS was hard sent from the gate to gain a forward position, dueled outside of BROADWAY EMPIRE through the opening quarter mile, spurted clear and angled in nearing the five eighths pole, was joined from the outside by BROADWAY EMPIRE after a half, took pressure past the three eighths marker, moved away under urging into the lane, wandered outward a bit leaving the three sixteenths pole, was straightened to widen a furlong out then held firm under a drive. GOLDEN TICKET settled well off the quick pace while saving ground, commenced his run leaving the three furlong marker, eased off the inside continuing his advance in upper stretch then kept on well to close the gap. BRUJO DE OLLEROS (BRZ) , washy pre race, was steadied off the heels of FED BIZ nearing the first turn, raced three wide down the backstretch, gained into the lane, shifted in a bit and finished with interest. VERRAZANO , in close pursuing between runners mid way on the first turn, was urged along chasing down the backstretch, came five wide for the drive, drifted out a bit inside the sixteenth pole and had a mild late kick. HYMN BOOK lagged back while removed from the inside, swung out very wide leaving the three sixteenths pole and had some belated action. FED BIZ chased outside rivals, raced six wide in upper stretch but came up empty. PANTS ON FIRE , hustled four wide into the first turn, dropped in chasing the leaders into the far turn, altered back out to make a slight move mid way on the final turn then faded in the drive. ALPHA was fidgety in the gate just prior to the start, broke slowly, lagged back, saved ground into the lane and could not recover. BROADWAY EMPIRE was urged from the gate to vie inside the winner, angled out when that one went clear, came back two wide to challenge after a half mile, pressed

to the five sixteenths marker then had nothing left for the final quarter mile. HOLY LUTE settled four wide, made a gradual progression past the five eighths pole, came under a ride to pursue around the far turn, could not kick on from there and retreated. CENTRALINTELLIGENCE was taken up inside rivals with about six and a half furlongs to go, shifted wide down the backstretch, faltered, was eased through the lane then was vanned off.
