Footnotes

I LOVE SILVER unhurried off the rail early, moved up inside on the second turn, split horses into the stretch, came out and rallied under a couple cracks of the whip and steady handling to prove best. BOSQUE REDONDO came off the rail and bid between horses leaving the first turn, stalked just off the inside on the backstretch and second turn, came three deep into the stretch and was second best. SO URGENT sent to the early lead and angled in, set a pressured pace inside and held the show. DIG FOR IT broke in and bumped a rival, settled outside a foe, dropped back on the second turn, came out some and improved position. BLADE PROSPECTOR (BRZ) had good early speed three deep then dueled outside a rival until past midstretch and weakened. RED EYE bumped at the start, angled in and saved ground chasing the pace and lacked the needed response. MILLENNIUM WIND bumped between horses at the start, pulled a bit into the first turn, chased outside a rival and gave way in the stretch.
