Footnotes

UNLIMITED VALUE dueled between foes then outside a rival, got clear on the turn, angled in entering the stretch and proved best under some urging and steady handling. TREASURED NOTE chased off the rail, came out at the spill on the turn, angled to the rail nearing the stretch and gained the place. CON QUIXOTE had speed four wide then stalked off the rail, came a bit wide into the stretch and lost second late. STORMY JACK sent along inside early, saved ground chasing the pace, swerved wide at the spill on the turn and finished with some interest. RIDE AND SHINE unhurried well off the rail early, also swerved wide at the spill on the turn and lacked the needed rally. EL DORADO SHOOTER dueled three deep between horses early then stalked off the rail, came out at the spill on the turn and weakened. RIO ORO had good early speed and dueled inside, broke down approaching midway on the turn and fell. MCCORDNSKUBA chased off the rail then angled in to save ground, fell over the fallen horses on the turn. The stewards conducted an inquiry into the spill on the turn but made no change to the original order of finish.
