**Footnotes**

GRANDEUR (IRE) stumbled badly at the start, angled in and settled outside a rival, split horses with a move forward leaving the second turn, came between foes again in midstretch, angled out a bit and rallied under urging to get up late while bumping with the runner-up on the line. SPEAKING OF WHICH (IRE) came off the rail in the run to the first turn and chased the pace, advanced three wide on the second turn to bid for the lead, gained the advantage nearing the stretch, inched away in midstretch, drifted out in deep stretch and held on well but could not contain the winner while bumping with that one on the wire. SMART ELLIS away a bit awkwardly, angled in and stalked inside, came out in upper stretch and finished with interest between horses late for the show. ALL SQUARED AWAY chased outside a rival then angled in on the first turn, awaited room briefly leaving the second turn, came out into the stretch and also finished with some interest but was edged for third. MY BEST BROTHER bumped and forced in at the start, angled in and dueled inside, put a head in front leaving the backstretch, fought back on the second turn and into the stretch and weakened late. POWER FOOT bobbled at the start then pulled his way along inside to chase the pace, came out into the stretch and again nearing midstretch and lacked the needed rally. OLD TIME HOCKEY bumped and pinched a bit at the start, angled in and chased outside a rival, was forced four wide leaving the second turn and into the stretch and could not offer the necessary late kick. HUNTSVILLE came in onto foes at the start, angled in and stalked outside a rival, lugged out and steadied nearing the quarter pole, came three deep into the stretch, drifted out and weakened. HOIST had speed outside then angled in and dueled outside a rival, fell back some leaving the second turn, came three wide into the stretch and had little left for the drive.
