Footnotes

NEW YEAR'S DAY settled about three wide down the backstretch, worked between runners after six furlongs, was guided down towards the rail leaving the three sixteenths marker, closed determinedly under strong handling, took over inside the sixteenth pole, kicked clear then held firm. HAVANA, three to four wide nearing the first turn, rated kindly off a contested pace, responded when asked leaving the far turn, bid two to three wide to engage STRONG MANDATE heading to the quarter pole, kicked clear while drifting out a bit in upper stretch, was hand ridden from there and failed to contain the winner. STRONG MANDATE was used four wide to join the pace fray past the seven eighths marker, disputed the issue three deep past the five eighths marker, dropped in going clear around the far turn, met the bid of HAVANA past the five sixteenths marker, gave chase past furlong grounds and kept on willingly to the wire. BOND HOLDER lagged back while saving ground, angled out and followed the winner through a seam entering the stretch, altered back towards

the rail for the final furlong but flattened out late. TAP IT RICH broke a step slow, was sent up between runners passing the wire the first time, was a bit rank when getting out six wide mid way on the first turn, regrouped to make some progress four wide leaving the far turn, chased into the lane but lacked a significant late response. MEXIKOMA came in at the break, was angled off the rail for the backstretch run, gained momentum past the three eighths pole, worked between runners in mid stretch, altered well wide departing the sixteenth marker and finished with good energy. WE MISS ARTIE bobbed at the break, quickly recovered and gained a forward position along the rail after a quarter mile, waited for room past the half mile marker, shifted out for a clear run inside the three eighths pole, made a five wide run in upper stretch to loom a presence but could not sustain in the final stages. DANCE WITH FATE was squeezed back at the break, angled four wide past the three quarter pole, made a decent run leaving the far turn, chased into the lane and gave way late. DIAMOND BACHELOR , four wide into the first turn, failed to menace. SMARTY'S ECHO came out at the break, was corrected soon after, angled five wide around the first turn, continued wide and failed to threaten. MEDAL COUNT , three wide chasing the early pace, dropped back after a half mile. RUM POINT bobbed at the break, regrouped and was sent to contention, vied between runners for a half mile, dropped back and was eased late. CONQUEST TITAN sprinted clear along the rail past the seven eighths pole, was joined into the backstretch, disputed the issue to the far turn then faltered.
