Footnotes

YOUNGOTTAWANNA stalked the pace outside, moved up three deep between horses to put a head in front on the second turn, fought back inside the runner-up through the stretch, regained the advantage in deep stretch and pulled clear late under urging. OFFICER off a bit slowly, settled off the inside, split rivals with a move forward on the backstretch, bid four wide on the second turn and three deep into the stretch, gained the lead in midstretch but could not match the winner late. SURPRIZED settled outside a rival then off the rail, advanced five wide on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and bested the rest while the rider lost the whip late. DEBONAIR JOE stalked the pace off the rail, bid between horses on the second turn, continued along the inside and weakened. LUSTY LATIN off a bit slowly and squeezed at the break, settled off the inside, moved up a bit off the rail leaving the second turn and improved position. RAINMAN'S REQUEST sped to the early lead, set the pace along the inside, duelled briefly on the second turn, then weakened. MIKE THE TIGER four wide into the first turn, chased in a good position outside to the second turn and dropped back. SHARPSTER five wide into the first turn, clipped heels on that bend, settled outside and did not rally. MIDNIGHT JIGALO unhurried off the rail early, raced wide throughout, moved up nearing the second turn but could not sustain the bid. WILLIE CRUISE unhurried between foes then off the rail, went four wide into the stretch and did not rally. GREEN TEAM settled inside, went outside a rival on the backstretch and three deep into the stretch and gave way. BID N ASK saved ground chasing the leaders, dropped back into and on the second turn, was pulled up and was vanned off.
