MASTER BELT (NZ) chased outside then three deep down the hill, came out for room in upper stretch and closed gamely under urging to get up late. I LOVE SILVER settled off the rail, advanced three deep leaving the hill, waited off heels in upper stretch until nearing the eighth pole, then rallied gamely between horses. KACHAMANDI (CHI) chased outside a rival then angled in on the hill, squeezed through between foes past midstretch, put a head in front in deep stretch and continued willingly. SARAFAN unhurried off the rail, swung out into the stretch and closed with a rush outside. EL CIELO chased the leaders off the rail, angled three deep into the stretch to loom a threat and was outfinished. MACWARD chased four wide then outside a rival down the hill, came four wide again into the stretch and could not offer the necessary late response. LOOKN EAST dueled outside a rival down the hill, was squeezed a bit while weakening in midstretch and fell back. IS IT TRUE MEX chased between horses then along the inside, came out a bit into the stretch, was boxed in through much of the drive, steadied off heels in midstretch, came out and could not recover. F J'S PACE had good early speed and dueled inside, inched away in the stretch and held on well but weakened late. FURTIVO (ARG) saved ground off the pace to the stretch and had no further response.
