STAKES Breeders' Cup Juvenile Filly Sprint Preview S. Listed - Thoroughbred

FOR FILLIES, TWO YEARS OLD. All Two-Year-Old entrants in Breeders' Cup races shall not have medications, or any other substances administered within 24 hours of post time including authorized bleeder medications otherwise permitted by state regulations. By subscription of \$100 each if made on or before Thursday, October 25, 2012 closed with 13. All horses to pay \$1,000 additional to start with \$75,000 added and an additional \$25,000 from the Breeders' Cup Fund for Cup Nominees only. The host association's money to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 12% to third, 6% to fourth and 2% to fifth. Breeders' Cup Fund monies also correspondingly divided providing a Breeders' Cup nominee has finished in an awarded position. Any Breeders' Cup moneynot awarded reverts back to the Fund. Preference will be given to Breeders' Cup Nominees only of equal weight. Weight: 122 lbs. Non-winners of \$55,000 allowed 2 lbs.; two races other than claiming, 4 lbs.; one race other than claiming, 6 lbs. UNUSUAL WAY had good early speed and angled in, set a pressured pace inside, inched clear in the stretch and proved best under left handed urging and steady handling late. SWITCH TO THE LEAD bumped at the start, was between horses early then pressed the pace outside the winner, could not match that one in the stretch but held second. TRULY MARIE bumped with the runner-up at the start, prompted the pace three deep then stalked off the rail, came three wide into the stretch and was edged for the place. BARES TRIPPER bobbed slightly at the start, pulled and steadied slightly nearing the gap, chased inside, came out into the stretch and lacked a further response. SULTRY SEASON chased outside then alongside a rival, dropped back off the rail on the turn, angled in some into the stretch, drifted in late and did not rally.
