Footnotes

GEORGE VANCOUVER saved ground chasing the pace, moved up inside into and on the second turn, came out into the stretch, squeezed between horses with a bid to gain the lead in midstretch and kicked clear under urging. NOBLE TUNE angled in and settled a bit off the rail then between foes into and on the second turn, came three deep into the stretch, angled out for room nearing midstretch and finished well for the place. BALANCE THE BOOKS

settled and angled in outside a rival, moved up some leaving the second turn, lacked room off heels into the drive, came out for a clear path twice in upper and midstretch and also finished well. DUNDONNELL pulled hard between foes and drifted out into the first turn, stalked outside then was in tight between foes a half mile out, bid four wide into the stretch, drifted in a bit onto the winner when between rivals in midstretch and was outfinished. GERVINHO had speed between horses then stalked inside, re-bid between rivals leaving the backstretch, dueled for the lead, fought back inside in the stretch and also was outkicked late for a minor award. ARTIGIANO saved ground chasing the pace, advanced along the rail on the second turn, split horses in deep stretch and lacked the needed late kick. LINES OF BATTLE had speed five wide then stalked outside a rival, went four wide on the second turn and five wide into the stretch and weakened. JOHA chased three deep on the first turn then outside, steadied between horses a half mile out, continued between foes and was in a bit tight leaving the second turn and could not summon the necessary response. BROWN ALMIGHTY bobbed at the start, pulled between foes early then three deep on the first turn, stalked on the backstretch, bid three wide to put a head in front leaving the second turn, dueled into the stretch, steadied when crowded between foes in midstretch and weakened. FANTASTIC MOON (GB) broke slowly, settled off the rail then three deep on the backstretch and into the second turn, came five wide into the stretch and did not rally. DRY SUMMER forced out into the first turn, settled off the rail, came three wide into the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. SUMMIT COUNTY went up inside to duel for the lead then inched away on the first turn, set the pace along the rail, battled inside rivals on the second turn and weakened in the stretch. KNOW MORE forced five wide into the first turn, chased outside on the backstretch and four wide on the second turn, came five wide into the stretch and did not rally. I'M BOUNDTOSCORE pulled between horses then bid three deep into the first turn, stalked outside a rival, bid again three wide leaving the backstretch, steadied while dropping back quickly between foes on the second turn and weakened.
