Footnotes

TAPIZAR, a bit washy pre race, moved up four wide into the first turn to attend the pace, eagerly drew alongside EMCEE with five eighths remaining, disputed the pace outside that rival to the quarter pole, spurred clear when sharply roused left handed in upper stretch, drifted out a bit when widening in mid stretch, was corrected soon after then held firm while shown the whip the final seventy yards. RAIL TRIP, forwardly placed inside rivals and off the rail, was lightly shuffled when a bit keen to go on mid way down the backstretch, shifted out past the three sixteenths pole and finished with good energy to gain the place. DELEGATION tracked inside under a rating hold, was in a bit tight nearing the far turn, got through along the rail nearing mid stretch and kept on willingly. JOHN SCOTT was steadied back near the five furlong marker, taken widest soon after, made progress five to six wide around the final turn, gave chase into the stretch and kept on with interest. JERSEY TOWN, under a firm hold between runners while stalking the pace, angled out for clear sailing in upper stretch, drifted out in mid stretch but could not generate the needed response. EMCEE gained command three wide into the first turn, set the pace in the two path, was hounded by the winner from the five eighths pole, relinquished command near the quarter pole then surrendered in the final furlong. SHACKLEFORD bobbled at the break, quickly gained four to five wide to reach a stalking spot with six furlongs to go, was nudged on to take aim leaving the far turn, gave hard pursuit into the lane then faded. FED BIZ, between rivals early, was hustled along off the rail leaving the far turn but failed to kick in. SECOND CITY, four wide, failed to menace and retreated around the final turn.
