Footnotes

BRINGEM JUNG dueled a bit off the rail on the backstretch and between foes on the turn and into the stretch, battled outside a rival in midstretch and inched clear under urging late. ACADEMY SPY pressed the pace four wide between horses then three deep into the turn, battled four wide again on the bend and into the stretch and gamely edged a rival for second. VAN ROUGE close up a bit off the rail early, bid inside on the turn and dueled until past midstretch, could not match the winner late and just lost the place. FUTURE MINISTER forced the pace six wide on the backstretch and five wide on the turn and into the stretch and weakened. BENDEROSA bobbled at the start, went up between horses to duel for command, battled three deep between foes on the turn and into the stretch and also weakened. PRIME TIME EVENT was in a good position chasing outside on the backstretch and five wide on the turn and weakened in the drive. IVAN MOTLEY off a bit awkwardly, settled off the rail then split horses on the backstretch, came three deep into the stretch and did not rally. DEFINITE EDGE close up between horses early then off the rail, dropped back on the turn and weakened. FEBRUARY STORM forced the pace five wide between horses then four wide into the turn, dropped back outside on the bend and had little left. TASTE OF PARADISE broke slowly, settled off the rail and failed to menace. STAGE SHOW off a bit slowly, raced wide throughout and was outrun. FLYING SOLDIER broke in a bit, settled off the inside, angled in on the turn and was not a threat.
