ZIVA a bit slow into stride, went up inside to stalk the pace, was shuffled back into the turn, continued inside, came out in midstretch, rallied between foes under left handed urging to gain the lead in deep stretch and proved best. CRESTON CUTIE squeezed a bit at the start, settled inside, came out on the turn and six wide into the stretch and finished well. FEISTY FRIEND pressed the pace five wide on the backstretch, angled in and stalked just off the rail on the turn, re-bid alongside a rival in the stretch to gain the lead, drifted out past midstretch then drifted in late and held third. STUPENDUS PRINCESS broke a bit slowly, chased inside, came out leaving the turn and into the stretch, angled back to the inside in midstretch and was outfinished for the show. SMOKEY LAKE chased between horses then outside a rival, came out leaving the turn and five wide into the stretch and was outfinished. MONEYTIZZY chased outside then three deep into the turn, came out five wide into the stretch, drifted in through the drive and lacked the needed rally. WHOLE ENCHILADA bobbed at the start, dropped back outside then off the rail, came four wide into the stretch and improved position. BENSANNA pressed the pace between

horses then stalked outside, came four wide into the stretch, was in a bit tight between foes in upper stretch and weakened. STREET RAT CRAZY had good early speed and dueled between horses, inched away and angled in on the turn, fought back in midstretch, then weakened. FOREVER ISMAY sent between horses then steadied in tight early, chased just off the rail, angled in on the turn and did not rally. CLEAR THE SET had speed between foes then dueled a bit off the rail, stalked on the turn and weakened in the stretch. FAMOUS TALENT forced the pace between horses then stalked between foes on the turn, came three deep into the stretch, was forced out and in a bit tight in upper stretch and dropped back.
