Footnotes

RHYTHM OF LIGHT (GB) a bit slow to begin, settled inside, came out on the second turn and four wide into the stretch, drifted in some in midstretch but rallied under energetic handling to gain the lead in deep stretch and inched away. A JEALOUS WOMAN stalked off the rail then bid alongside a rival on the backstretch and second turn, took the lead into the stretch, inched away in midstretch and held on well but could not contain the winner late while clearly second best. VIVO PER LEI saved ground stalking the pace, waited a bit off heels leaving the second turn, came out slightly into the stretch, waited again then split horses in midstretch and gained the show inside. I DAZZLE stalked three deep on the first turn and backstretch, continued outside a rival on the second turn, came three wide into the stretch, was between horses in midstretch and was outfinished for third. HARD TO RESIST angled in and saved ground off the pace, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. BYRONY (IRE) chased between horses then a bit off the rail into and on the second turn, came out into the stretch and could not offer the necessary late kick. LET'S GO CHEYENNE between foes early, angled in and set the pace inside, dueled on the backstretch and second turn and weakened in the stretch.
