ENDLESS CRUISE stalked off the rail, bid three deep into the stretch, exchanged bumps with NATE DAWG while taking the lead in upper stretch, drifted out under left handed urging past midstretch but won clear. DANGER RANGER settled four wide then out from the inside, came out four wide again into the stretch, drifted in through the final furlong but gained the place. NATE DAWG had speed between horses then dueled outside a rival, exchanged bumps with the winner in upper stretch and weakened but held third. OFFICER JONES a bit slow to begin, settled off the rail then angled in, saved ground on the turn, came a bit off the fence in the stretch and lacked the needed rally. BIG HANDS AL had good early speed and dueled inside, fought back on the turn but weakened in the stretch.
