Footnotes

APHORISM pulled between horses early, stalked just off the rail, came out in upper stretch and rallied under left handed urging to wear down the runner-up and got up on the line. TWELVE FOLDS had good early speed and angled in, dueled between foes then outside a rival, battled between horses again leaving the turn, inched away into the stretch, kicked clear but was caught on the wire. SALAH'S DANCER prompted the pace three deep then stalked outside a rival into the turn, re-bid three wide leaving the turn and held third. LIGHT UP THE SKY between foes early, chased just off the rail, came out nearing midstretch and lacked the needed rally. WILLOW SWITCH in a bit tight early, chased off the rail or outside a rival, came three deep into the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. SPRING BLOOM settled outside a rival then a bit off the rail, went around a foe into the stretch and was not a threat. MARY CONTRARY angled in and dueled inside, fought back on the turn but weakened in the stretch. YA WANNNA HUG broke out a bit, was between horses early then chased off the rail or outside, went three deep on the turn and four wide into the stretch and lacked a further response. CAJUN MARKET broke a bit slowly, went up inside to chase the pace, saved ground on the turn and weakened in the stretch.
