Footnotes

SURPLUS chased outside a rival, went three deep on the second turn and into the stretch, bid alongside foes in midstretch, gained the lead past the eighth pole, kicked clear under left handed urging while drifting in and proved best. VISUAL INTENSITY saved ground chasing the pace, awaited room leaving the second turn, got through along the fence in the stretch, came out a bit late and was second best. MOSCATO settled outside a rival, came out on the second turn and five wide into the stretch and just got the show four wide on the wire. STARSPANGLED HEAT chased between horses, continued between rivals through the drive and just missed third. LODI RED settled outside then three deep, came out five wide into the stretch, lugged in a bit through the drive and was between foes on the line. HE FLIES A BANNER angled in and pulled his way to the lead then dueled outside a rival, was between horses in midstretch and weakened in the final furlong. CRANKY JACK also pulled early, dueled inside, fought back on the second turn and until midstretch and weakened. BUD

I CRUSHED IT settled inside then a bit off the rail, split horses leaving the second turn, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. SIR BELL angled in and stalked outside a rival or just off the rail, was between horses in the stretch and weakened. SYNCUBEAT saved ground stalking the pace, came out a bit for room into the stretch and also weakened. VALLEY CAT settled off the pace inside, saved ground throughout and was not a threat. KESSABTSI chased three deep, steadied between horses while dropping back on the second turn and weakened.
