Footnotes

MO CHEESE had speed between horses then stalked off the rail, awaited room leaving the turn and into the stretch, split horses in midstretch, bid toward the inside to gain the lead in deep stretch and held under urging. FREEWAYRACER stalked between horses then outside a rival, steadied into the turn, came out four wide into the stretch and finished well. MY LITTLE MORGAN stalked outside, came three deep into the stretch, gained a slim advantage in midstretch, fought back in deep stretch and bested the others. SCENT OF CHRISM broke a bit slowly, saved ground off the pace, came out into the stretch and finished with some interest. QUEENOF CALIFORNIA pulled her way along three deep then dueled outside a rival, drifted out some into the stretch and weakened in the final furlong. PORTFOLIO stalked the pace inside, was in a bit tight into the turn, got through along the rail in the stretch, came out late and lacked the needed rally. WARREN'S IDOL between foes early, settled off the rail, continued outside a rival on the turn, came out into the stretch and did not rally. OCTOGARIAN a bit slow to begin, had speed between horses then dueled inside, fought back on the turn, came a bit off the rail in the stretch and had little left in the stretch.
