LEXICON sped to the early lead, set the pace a bit off the rail, inched clear past midstretch and held gamely under urging. MASTER O FOXHOUNDS wide early, continued outside, angled in some for the turn and rallied gamely between rivals in the stretch. GO NOT WHOA, bumped at the start, also was wide early and three deep on the turn, came four wide into the stretch and finished well. CARPET RIDE pressed the pace three deep to the stretch and continued willingly. MARVY SAL was without early speed, came off the inside and wide into the stretch with a late bid. CAPOTEVILLE, saved ground, came out into the stretch, split rivals in midstretch and lacked the needed rally. TERSE also saved ground close up, was a bit crowded in midstretch and weakened. MEADOW PRAYER prompted the pace between rivals to the stretch and weakened. SHEGARDI bumped both sides at the start, went between horses into and on the turn and also weakened.
