LUMINOUS PRIZE, stalked outside a rival, went up three deep into and on the second turn, then wore down ASHCREEK under urging and inched clear late. ASHCREEK, saved ground early, went outside HEART'S MAGIC to challenge leaving the backstretch, took the lead on the second turn and kicked clear but could not hold off the winner. NO ETAL, saved ground stalking the pace, split rivals on the second turn and gained the show. MATANAH (GB), drifted out into the first turn, stalked outside on the backstretch and three deep on the second turn and lacked the needed rally. FLIMSY (GB) bobbled at the start, was carried wide into the first turn, continued to chase outside, was three deep on the second turn and also lacked a rally. SUSANNE (GB), off a bit slowly, saved ground close up and weakened. HEART'S MAGIC, quickly sped to the front and the rail, set the pace inside, dueled inside the runner-up into the second turn, then steadily dropped back.
