DEBONAIR JOE broke alertly then settled off the rail or outside, moved up three then four wide on the turn and five wide into the stretch and closed gamely under urging to get up at the wire. TOTAL LIMIT had good early speed off the rail, angled in and dueled four wide then outside a rival, gained a short advantage past midstretch and held on well but was caught while between foes late. AMERICAN SYSTEM vied for command between horses early then dueled inside the runner-up, fought back through the final furlong and also went willingly to the wire. GOLDEN HARE settled off the rail, went up outside on the turn and four wide into the stretch, was between horses in midstretch and finished with interest. CASTLE GANDOLFO three deep early, settled a bit off the rail, split rivals on the turn, came out in the stretch and lacked the needed rally. MY COUSIN MATT prompted the pace five wide then stalked five deep on the backstretch and four wide on the turn and also could not offer the necessary late kick. U S S TINOSA unhurried and angled in early, came out on the turn and into the stretch and improved position. TIMELY ACTION off a bit slowly, chased between horses on the backstretch and turn and weakened in the stretch. MAYAKOVSKY went up inside to press the pace, dropped back leaving the backstretch and into the turn and had little left. SHAH JEHAN well placed forcing or chasing four wide between horses on the backstretch and three deep on the turn, weakened. SUNDAY BREAK (JPN) prompted the pace between horses then stalked leaving the backstretch, continued inside on the turn and in the stretch and also had little left.
