Footnotes

TOUGH GAME lugged out some while sprinting to the early lead, set the pace a bit off the rail, angled back in on the turn, kicked clear and drew off under a steady hand ride. ARSEN allowed to settle off the rail, angled in on the turn and rallied along the inside for second. RIDE AND SHINE pulled his way between horses to stalk the early pace, continued off the inside, came out four wide into the stretch and just got the show. IRISHEYESSAREFLYING angled in and stalked the winner along the inside, came off the rail on the turn and out into the stretch and just lost third. LEGENDARY WEAVE broke out a bit, was sent along wide early, stalked outside then off the rail, continued outside a rival on the turn, came three deep into the stretch and weakened. TRADITIONAL unhurried inside on the backstretch, moved up some along the rail on the turn, came out into the stretch and did not rally. CRACKUP chased outside then off the rail, was caught wide midway on the turn, angled in between foes leaving the bend and also lacked a rally. DEBONAIR JOE stalked between horses then outside leaving the backstretch, dropped back on the turn, came four wide into the stretch and gave way.
