UNCLE DENNY angled in and dueled inside, inched away in midstretch, got clear and held on gamely under urging. ICED OUT allowed to settle off the rail, came four wide into the stretch and closed willingly. LUCKY J. H. stalked the pace along the inside, continued on the rail in the stretch, could not match the top pair late but bested the others. SHANGHAI JOE had good early speed and forced the pace three deep to the stretch but weakened in the final furlong. SYMBOLIC GESTURE chased off the rail then outside on the backstretch and turn, came three deep into the stretch and could not offer the necessary late response. SENOR FANGO chased outside a rival then between horses, dropped back on the backstretch, continued outside a foe on the turn and did not rally. STELLAR MAGIC vied for command between horses to the stretch and weakened. WIND WATER settled a bit off the rail then inside, remained along the fence in the stretch and was not a threat.
