Footnotes

KIP DEVILLE stalked the pace inside then a bit off the rail on the second turn, waited off heels leaving that turn, steadied in tight then split rivals in midstretch, bid along the rail, gained the lead in deep stretch and gamely prevailed under urging. AWESOME GEM between horses early, chased outside then alongside a rival, came out in the stretch and rallied between foes to gain the place late. ZANN settled outside a rival then inside on the backstretch, moved up along the rail on the second turn, came out off heels for room in the stretch and also rallied between foes. PORTO SANTO (FR) unhurried off the rail then outside foes leaving the backstretch and on the second turn, came five wide into the stretch and finished well. IN SUMMATION pulled his way along inside then between horses on the backstretch and second turn, came three deep into the stretch and also finished with interest. GET FUNKY angled in and dueled outside a rival then three deep on the backstretch, stalked outside a foe on the second turn, re-bid three wide in midstretch and weakened late. BEDLAM BERTIE rank early, pulled his way between horses to gain the lead on the backstretch, dueled outside a rival on the second turn and between foes again in midstretch and also weakened late. LIGHTNING HIT (IRE) settled off the pace inside then a bit off the rail on the second turn, swung out wide into the stretch and could not summon the necessary late kick. LIKE RUNNING WATER three deep early, chased outside, came four wide into the stretch and weakened. TENT (IRE) angled in and dueled inside, fought back on the second turn but weakened in the stretch. CRESTED (GB) chased a bit off the rail then inside, was in tight off heels in midstretch and again in deep stretch and lacked the needed response. SARTORIAL stalked between horses

then outside, went three deep on the second turn and into the stretch and weakened.
