HOODS UP chased outside then three deep on the turn, came four wide into the stretch, rallied under urging to gain a slim lead in deep stretch and held gamely. LIBERTY WATCH broke in a bit, dueled three deep then outside a rival into and on the turn, inched away leaving the bend, fought back in deep stretch and went willingly to the wire. TIZ WEST settled off the rail, was climbing into the turn, came a bit wide into the stretch and gained the show late. EL MARTILLO saved ground stalking the pace, remained along the rail in the stretch and lost third late. SMOKIN' STOGIES chased between horses then off the rail, angled in on the turn and did not rally. NO LIEN HERE between foes early, prompted the pace inside, was in a bit tight nearing the quarter pole, came out into the stretch and weakened. PEACE PROSPECT chased between horses on the backstretch and turn, came three deep into the stretch and weakened. FRIENDLY HALF sped to the early lead off the rail, dueled between horses then stalked on the turn, steadied between rivals into the stretch and also weakened. A claim of foul by the rider of NO LIEN HERE against the runner-up for alleged interference leaving the turn was not allowed by the stewards, who ruled though the former was in a bit close, there was sufficient room nearing the quarter pole.
