Footnotes

ALL SAINT wide early, chased outside then off the rail on the turn, came three deep into the stretch, lugged inward nearing midstretch and again past the eighth pole, gained the advantage under some left handed urging a sixteenth out and proved best. FEISTY SUANCES went up inside to duel for the lead, brushed with a rival in midstretch, came a bit off the rail, put a head in front past the eighth pole and just held second. ATTICUS JACK pulled early, chased outside then three deep, continued alongside a rival leaving the turn and gained the show. DANNY Q was wide between horses early then dropped back outside, angled in alongside a rival on the backstretch, came out leaving the turn and four wide into the stretch and just missed third. BEAUTEOUS MAXIMUS settled off the rail then outside leaving the turn, came four wide into the stretch and was outfinished. LORDGIVEMEALIFT duelled outside a rival, brushed with that one in midstretch, was between horses past midstretch and weakened late. UNBRIDLED ROMAN a bit slow to begin, settled just off the rail on the backstretch and turn and could not summon the necessary late kick. MENSA HEAT stalked inside then a bit off the rail leaving the turn and into the stretch, drifted in and weakened. DONTMESROUNDWITJIM settled off the rail then inside, came out leaving the turn and four wide into the stretch and was not a threat. STAR REDEEMER broke a bit slowly, chased inside on the backstretch and turn, steadied in tight along the fence into the stretch and weakened. THE BAT SIGNAL chased between horses then outside a rival, came three deep into the stretch and had little left for the drive. JACK FLASH stalked between rivals on the backstretch and most of the turn, came out into the stretch and also weakened.
