Footnotes

AUTOCUE (GB) three deep into the first turn, settled outside a rival, split horses on the second turn, came out into the stretch and again in upper stretch and rallied under urging to get up late. STREETS OF HEAVEN chased outside then alongside a rival, went between foes on the backstretch and second turn, came out four wide into the stretch, drifted in some in midstretch and gained a short advantage, drifted in again past midstretch and continued willingly. ABSOLUTE GLORY chased a bit off the rail then inside, dropped back some on the second turn, came out nearing midstretch and finished willingly to best the rest. JAMES PRIOR chased just off the rail then between horses, angled in for the second turn, came out into the stretch, bid between foes approaching midstretch, brushed with the runner-up in a bit tight, was forced in some past midstretch and was outfinished. SUPER HARMONY angled in and stalked inside then off the rail, bid alongside a foe then between horses into the stretch, put a head in front, fought back in midstretch while drifting out a bit and was outfinished late. GRAFTON angled in and settled just off the inside, came out some in the stretch and lacked the needed rally. ONE SHOT (ARG) stumbled at the start but quickly recovered, had speed outside a rival then angled in and set the pace inside, dueled on the second turn, fought back into the stretch and weakened in the final furlong. DINNER AT JAKE'S a bit slow to begin, pulled his way along inside then off the rail, went outside foes on the backstretch and three deep on the second turn, came out five wide into the stretch and did not rally. SMOOTH AND SAVVY allowed to settle off the inside, went outside a rival on the backstretch, came out some into the stretch and was not a threat. CORONEL MOLDES pulled inside then off the rail, continued outside foes

on the backstretch and second turn, came out into the stretch and weakened. A claim of foul by the rider of JAMES PRIOR against the runner-up for alleged interference in the stretch was not allowed by the stewards, who ruled the tight quarters in midstretch did not alter the original order of finish.
