Footnotes

M ONE RIFLE broke inward, sped to the early lead, angled in and set the pace a bit off the rail then inside, kicked away in the stretch and held on gamely under left handed urging. MISREMEMBERED stalked inside then a bit off the rail, angled in again leaving the turn and came up the rail for the place. PAPA CLEM stalked between horses then outside a rival, came three deep into the stretch, was between horses in late stretch and just held third. SUPREME SUMMIT a bit slow to begin, angled in and settled inside, came out on the turn and four wide into the stretch, angled inward nearing midstretch, came out in deep stretch and just missed the show. HUNCH a bit crowded at the start, stalked outside then three deep, came four wide into the stretch and was outfinished for a minor award between foes late. SQUARE EDDIE close up stalking the winner a bit off the rail then inside, came out leaving the turn and into the stretch, was between horses in deep stretch and weakened late. SMART BID well placed stalking the pace between foes then outside a rival leaving the turn and into the stretch, could not offer the necessary response. CORONET OF A BARON in a bit tight after the start, chased between foes, was in tight again into the turn, came four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. JERANIMO settled between horses then a bit off the rail, came out three deep into the stretch and was not a threat. MYTHICAL POWER unhurried outside a rival then a bit off the rail, came out on the turn and six wide into the stretch and did not rally. JOIN IN THE DANCE steadied in tight just after the start, was rank between foes then chased inside, came out into the stretch and

lacked a rally. KINSELLA outside a rival early, pulled his way between horses on the backstretch and turn, came out into the stretch and lacked a further response. NEW BAY a bit crowded between foes early, chased outside, came five wide into the stretch and weakened.
