VALLEY CAT chased three deep then off the rail, moved up outside leaving the second turn and four wide into the stretch, bid outside a rival in midstretch, gained the lead under urging nearing the sixteenth marker and held gamely. NO STADIUM angled in and chased inside then a bit off the rail on the backstretch, came out on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and finished well. LUCKY FITZ between horses early, stalked outside a rival then bid alongside the pacesetter on the backstretch, took a short lead between foes leaving the second turn, fought back off the rail in the stretch and continued willingly. JONES BROTHER pulled inside then tugged his way along to stalk between horses on the backstretch and second turn, drifted in some in the stretch and was outfinished. DAVE'S RULER saved ground stalking the pace throughout and could not offer the necessary response. LOOKING FOR CANDY a bit slow to begin, chased outside, came four wide into the stretch and did not rally. B'S LUCKY STRIKE also a bit slow into stride, went four wide into the first turn then settled outside a rival, came out four wide again into the stretch and was not a threat. KIM'S LEADING MAN pulled between horses then tugged his way along off the rail, angled in leaving the backstretch, came out into the stretch and could not offer the needed response. TAKE A HARD LOOK stalked outside foes then bid three deep on the second turn, continued alongside the runner-up into the stretch and weakened in the final furlong.

ANGA allowed to settle a bit off the rail, came out some into the stretch, angled inward in the drive and failed to menace. WARREN'S PRANCER had speed off the rail then outside a rival, inched away leaving the first turn, angled in and dueled inside on the backstretch and second turn, dropped back into the stretch and weakened.
