Footnotes

KESSABTSI stalked the pace outside a rival, came three deep into the stretch, bid three wide in midstretch, gained the lead under left handed urging in deep stretch and proved best. CLEARANCE CLARENCE had speed outside a rival then angled in and inched away on the first turn, dueled inside on the backstretch and second turn, came out a bit into the stretch, fought back on a short advantage in midstretch, could not match the winner late but held the place. EL TANGO RAY stalked inside then between horses on the second turn and into the stretch and just got the show. PERSONALITARY stalked early then bid alongside a rival on the backstretch and three deep into the second turn, battled outside the pacesetter on that turn and into the stretch, was between foes in midstretch and was edged late for third. UZZIAH threw his head at the start, settled inside then went outside a rival on the backstretch, swung out into the stretch and finished with interest outside. MY T QUICK angled in and settled outside a rival, went three deep on the second turn and four wide passing the quarter pole, came five wide into the stretch and was outfinished. PANTHER'S CLAW pulled between horse then angled in and chased inside, moved up along the rail into and on the second turn, steadied in tight entering the stretch and could not summon the necessary late kick. SANIBEL SID chased three deep then outside a rival, split horses three wide leaving the second turn, came four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. WARREN'S BIG CAT chased between horses then outside, went four wide on the second turn and six wide into the stretch and also lacked the necessary late response. MYHORSEOF COURSE saved ground off the pace, came off the rail on the second turn, angled out into the stretch and was not a threat. KING RED pulled his way along and was in a bit tight inside into the first turn, stalked along the rail, bid between foes into the second turn, fell back some

leaving that bend, was three deep between foes into the stretch and weakened.
