Footnotes

MR. BOSSY PANTS stalked a bit off the rail then inside, came out into the stretch, bid alongside the pacesetter in midstretch, put a head in front under urging between foes in deep stretch and gamely prevailed. LAMM stalked outside then alongside a rival, was fanned out four wide into the stretch, bid three wide in deep stretch and continued willingly to the end. INUIT FISHER sped to the early lead, set the pace along the inside, fought back from the rail through the final furlong and continued gamely to the wire. ADAM SUANCES chased a bit off the rail then inside on the hill and through the stretch and was outfinished. RAINBOW GOOSE stumbled at the start to be away slowly, settled off the rail, entered the stretch alongside a rival, came out in the drive and

lacked the needed late kick. KELLY LEAK chased outside then three deep on the hill, came four wide into the stretch and could not summon the necessary late response. DRESS CODE stalked the pace three deep then outside on the hill, came three wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. SHEM between foes early, stalked just off the rail then inside, came out slightly into the stretch and could not offer the needed response. EL MERITO (CHI) settled off the rail, swung four wide into the stretch and was not a threat. QUIETLY MINE chased between horses then just off the inside to the stretch and did not rally. COO CACHOO had speed off the inside then stalked the leader just off the fence, drifted out crossing the dirt and weakened. Rail on hill at zero.
