Footnotes

TIME TO DOUBLEDOWN had good early speed and dueled inside, fought back to a short lead just past midstretch and gamely prevailed under left handed urging and strong handling. GOODBYE CHARLIE wide early, angled in and dueled outside the winner throughout, fought back when headed past midstretch and continued willingly. SOUTHERN HEART close up stalking the pace inside, came out leaving the turn and into the stretch and also went on well to the end. SKY FOX chased a bit off the rail then inside leaving the backstretch and on the turn and into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. RUN CHARLIE RUN five wide early, stalked four wide then three deep into and out of the turn and could not offer the necessary response. BALLADERO wide early, pulled his way along outside then off the rail, angled to the inside on the turn and improved position along the rail in the stretch. TRIBUNAL BLUES

also wide early, chased outside then three deep on the turn and four wide into the stretch and could not offer the needed late kick. MR. CAPPUCINO chased between horses then a bit off the rail on the turn and into the stretch and weakened. CALIFORNIA WALLOP hesitated to be away slowly, settled outside then alongside a rival, angled in on the turn, came out into the stretch and was not a threat. DEBITS AND CREDITS stalked between horses then outside on the turn, came three deep into the stretch and weakened. COLD BAY settled off the rail then angled in, lugged out some into the stretch and lacked a further response. PAVEMENT broke slowly, raced unhurried along the inside, came out a bit into the stretch and was not a factor. TIME TO DOUBLEDOWN wore calks.
