Footnotes

SILENTIO angled in and stalked outside a rival, came three wide into the stretch, took the lead three deep in midstretch and gamely prevailed under some urging. BATTLE FORCE also angled in outside a rival then found the rail on the first turn, saved ground chasing the pace, came out into the stretch and finished well. PRESS BARON (GB) stalked the pace inside, came out in midstretch, rallied between horses then toward the inside in late stretch. BIG BANE THEORY had speed between horses then angled in and set the pace inside, dueled on the backstretch and second turn, fought back in midstretch and weakened late. MIDNIGHT CROONER stalked a bit off the rail then pressed the pace outside a rival, fought back between horses in midstretch and weakened. CONSPIRACY a bit slow to begin, angled in and settled inside, went outside a rival on the second turn, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. SMART ELLIS pulled early, chased outside a rival, came three wide into the stretch and could not summon the necessary response. FIT TO RULE sent inside, saved ground chasing the pace, dropped back on the second turn, came out into the stretch and gave way.
