JIMMY CREED saved ground stalking the pace, came out in upper stretch, bid outside the runner-up to gain the lead under urging a sixteenth out and gamely prevailed. PRIVATE ZONE sped to the early lead, set a pressured pace a bit off the rail, inched away inside nearing the turn, fought back along the rail past midstretch and continued willingly inside the winner. UNBRIDLED'S NOTE chased outside a rival or off the rail, continued outside on the turn and three deep into the stretch and picked up the show. DRILL broke a bit slowly, settled off the rail, came out on the turn and four wide into the stretch and put in a late bid at a minor award. GUILT TRIP chased off the rail then outside a rival into and on the turn, came three wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. FED BIZ broke a bit slowly, chased inside then just off the rail leaving the backstretch and on the turn, angled back in through the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. THE LUMBER GUY pulled some and pressed the pace outside a rival then stalked a bit off the inside, was between horses into the stretch and weakened in the final furlong. POLITICALLYCORRECT settled off the inside then angled in on the backstretch, saved ground on the turn, came out into the stretch and did not rally. BASMATI stalked the pace outside a rival, came three deep into the stretch and weakened.
