MAGICAL ALLURE forced the pace outside rivals, dueled three deep on the turn, took a short lead nearing midstretch, drifted in a bit despite left handed urging while inching away in deep stretch and held on gamely. GOURMET GIRL, saved ground off the early pace, came out on the turn and four wide into the stretch, split rivals in deep stretch and closed gamely. TRANQUILITY LAKE, not far back outside GOURMET GIRL early and outside LA MADAME nearing the turn, swung five wide into the stretch and finished well. HOLY NOLA drifted out at the start but shot to the early lead, angled in and dueled inside into and on the turn and until past midstretch but weakened late. BRULAY vied for the lead between rivals to midstretch, steadied while weakening a sixteenth out and dropped back. LA MADAME (CHI) a bit crowded at the start, raced outside GOURMET GIRL early, continued toward the inside and weakened. GOLDENFLAG was outrun inside early, came out on the turn and failed to menace. The stewards conducted an inquiry into the stretch run but made no change when they ruled the trouble to BRULAY did not alter the original order of finish.
