Footnotes

JERANIMO saved ground chasing the pace, moved up along the rail into the stretch, bid inside in midstretch, gained the lead past the eighth pole and kicked clear under steady handling. PROUDINSKY (GER) close up stalking the pace inside, bid along the fence on the second turn, took the lead a quarter mile out, inched away briefly off the fence in upper stretch, battled alongside the winner in midstretch, could not match that one in the final furlong but was clearly second best. THE USUAL Q. T. tracked the leader outside the runner-up, bid three deep on the second turn and into the stretch and weakened in the final furlong but held third. EXPANSION broke a bit slowly, angled in and saved ground throughout and put in a late bid at a minor award. METEORE chased outside a rival or off the rail, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. MEDICI CODE (GB) bobbled at the start, settled off the rail then outside a rival on the second turn and into the stretch and did not rally. VIOLON SACRE took the early lead and angled in, set the pace inside then a bit off the rail leaving the backstretch, battled between horses on the second turn and weakened in the stretch.
