MISS MARSHA LEE was sent along to the early lead, set the pace a bit off the rail, kicked clear under urging in the stretch and just held. SWEET CONSOLIDATOR bobbled at the start, stalked a bit off the rail then inside, came out on the turn and three deep into the stretch, drifted out some in the final furlong but finished well to just miss. HOMEWORK stalked the pace three deep then off the rail on the turn, came four wide into the stretch and held third. EXPONENTIAL a bit awkwardly into stride, settled off the rail, angled in some for the turn, swung out into the stretch and just missed the show. ONE MORE PALO stalked the pace three deep on the backstretch and a bit off the rail on the turn and lacked the needed rally. MISS I CARLY bobbled at the start, settled between horses then off the rail, angled in some on the turn and could not offer the necessary response. PERSONAL JOKE close up stalking the pace between horses then off the rail on the turn, found the fence in the stretch and weakened. TIZ FINAL a bit slow into stride, settled inside, split horses on the turn, came out into the stretch and was not a threat. JACK'S GLO chased between horses then a bit off the rail leaving the backstretch, found the fence on the turn and weakened. CHANA'S GIRL settled outside rivals then chased three deep, continued outside on the turn and four wide into the stretch and had little left for the drive.
