Footnotes

COOL SAMURAI settled inside then came off the rail on the first turn, chased off the inside then three deep leaving the backstretch, on the second turn and into the stretch and rallied under left handed urging to get up outside foes late. THE ADMIRAL had speed outside a rival then stalked just off the rail, bid alongside that one leaving the second turn, was floated out a bit into the stretch, put a head in front in midstretch, fought back between foes in late stretch but could not hold off the winner. ROUGH PASSAGE had good early speed inside, set the pace inside then a bit off the rail, angled in again for the second turn, came out some into the stretch, fought back in the drive, drifted inward in the final sixteenth and held third. ICY RIDE fractious in the gate and away a bit slowly, pulled between foes then chased just off the rail, found the inside for the second turn, remained inside in the stretch and lacked the needed rally. FUZZY LOGIC three deep into the first turn, chased off the rail then between foes leaving the backstretch, continued out from the fence on the second turn, came out into the stretch and lacked a further response.
