Footnotes

PAPA'S PAISLEY angled in on the first turn and chased inside, moved up leaving the second turn, came out in upper stretch and rallied under urging to get up outside foes nearing the wire. RUNAWAY QUE dueled three deep then outside a rival, battled between horses leaving the second turn and in the stretch, fought back to regain a slim advantage in the drive and held on well but was caught late. BLUEGRASS FOX TROT stalked inside then outside a rival, bid three deep on the second turn and in the stretch and just held third. ANYTHINGTOGETEVEN sent inside to duel for the lead, battled along the rail throughout, fought back in the stretch and went willingly to the wire. ILLYBILLY BOY angled in and settled just off the rail then inside, moved up some then steadied in tight midway on the second turn, continued toward the rail and improved position. SAMURAI ASSAULT forced out into the first turn, chased outside or off the rail, angled in some on the second turn and did not rally. HEAVENELEVEN broke slowly, angled in and pulled under a hold then came out on the first turn, continued a bit off the rail on the second turn then swung four wide into the stretch and did not rally. REPS AND WARRANTS pulled between horses to press the pace then stalked a bit off the rail, fell back on the second turn, drifted four wide into the stretch and had little left for the drive. STILL UNBROKEN had speed four wide then angled in and stalked outside a rival, steadied sharply off heels midway on the second turn, swung into the stretch and gave way. CACTUS SHINES pulled hard between foes and steadied early, angled in between foes then lugged out and steadied into the first turn, chased outside, also dropped back on the second turn, came four wide into the stretch and also gave way and was eased in the lane.
