Footnotes

STONEBRIDGE LADY angled in and pressed the pace outside a rival, took a short lead on the backstretch, kicked clear on the second turn and drew off while being kept to the task. ROYAL SKY off a bit slowly, angled to the rail and saved ground off the pace, came out on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and gained the place. DIAMOND TIARA a half step slow to begin, went up three deep into the first turn, stalked off the rail on the backstretch, went three wide into the second turn, continued outside a rival on that bend and saved the show. BRING ON THE MUSIC also off a bit slowly, settled just off the rail, swung four wide into the stretch and improved position. PERSONIFY between horses early, stalked a bit off the rail, came out slightly into the stretch and lacked a further response. LADY KATY DID settled off the rail, split horses into the second turn, continued outside and could not offer the needed late kick. MONEYINDESBANK angled in and dueled on a short lead, stalked the winner on the second turn and weakened. LIVE FREE OR DIE saved ground chasing the pace, dropped back early on the second turn, came off the rail, steadied off heels a quarter mile out and weakened. CAT BALLADO four wide into the first turn, chased outside, went five wide into the second turn, angled in some leaving that bend and also weakened.
