STRIKING SONG sped to the early lead then dueled inside, inched away on the backstretch, kicked clear in the stretch and held under urging. SLIPPERY WHEN BET four wide into the first turn, stalked three deep on the backstretch and second turn and just got the place. POHAVE between horses early, dueled outside the winner then stalked that one off the rail to the stretch and just lost second between foes at the wire. GOOD MEETING bobbled a bit at the start, came off the rail into the backstretch, moved up outside into the second turn, split rivals in the drive and just missed a minor award. PUERTO BANUS chased off the rail on the first turn and backstretch, angled to the inside on the second turn and did not rally. MARSHALL ROOSTER (GB) allowed to settle outside a rival to the stretch, was not a factor. SPACELINK three deep into the first turn, chased between foes, dropped back leaving the backstretch, angled in on the second turn and gave way. PAVLOVSK saved ground off the pace, fell back midway on the backstretch, also gave way and was eased.
