UNBRIDLED'S NOTE stalked a bit off the rail then inside, came out a bit in upper stretch, bid alongside the runner-up past midstretch and gamely prevailed under some urging and good handling. EL COMMODORE had good early speed to stalk the pace inside, inherited the lead into the stretch, inched away, fought back inside through the final furlong and went willingly to the wire. GALLANT SON stumbled at the start, settled outside then alongside a rival, came out five wide into the stretch and finished with interest. CHIPS ALL IN chased off the rail then outside rivals, continued three deep down the hill, came out some into the stretch and lacked the needed rally but was edged for the show. HANDSOME MIKE steadied between horses nearing the right hand curve, angled in and chased inside on the hill and into and through the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. AIN'T NO OTHER stalked off the rail then between rivals on the hill and into the stretch and weakened. TRUEST LEGEND sped to the early lead, set the pace a bit off the rail, drifted out into the stretch, was being pulled up through the drive and was vanned off. Rail on hill at zero.
