WHO'S KIDDING WHO off a bit slowly, moved up inside, steadied off heels midway on the backstretch, pulled his way up inside into and on the turn, came out leaving the bend, swept to the front three deep into the stretch and drew clear under a brisk hand ride until the final strides. SNODEN allowed to settle off the rail, also came three deep into the stretch and picked up the place. JULIESUGARDADDY a bit slow to begin, chased just off the rail then inside on the turn, split horses in deep stretch and gained the show late inside. SWEEPING VISION chased off the inside then outside a rival on the turn, also went between horses in deep stretch and was edged for third. INDIAN DAY hustled between horses to duel for the lead, battled outside a rival on the turn and between foes again into the stretch and weakened. TALE OF THE HILLS had good early speed and dueled inside, fought back on the turn and into the stretch and also weakened. SENATOR MATTY forced the pace three deep on the backstretch, dropped back off the rail on the turn and gave way.
